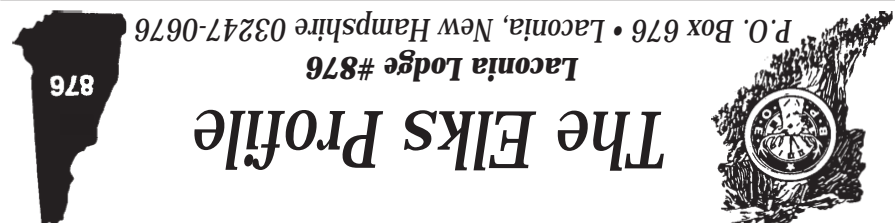
bers donate so I am asking everyone to please do what you can to get us at least to our per capita.

A Message from the Esteemed Leading Knight

Well September is upon us, our children are starting back to school, drive with care. Please don't use your cell phones while driving because our children are in groups and many are not paying attention so as drivers we must pay close attention to what is going on around us. We must protect our future.

For all of you who have not returned your charity raffle ticket stubs and money, time is on us, the drawing is at the meeting Sep. 19th. Please consider buying the ticket yourself if you did not sell them. This is a very big part of the money we have to do the charity work in our community and programs.

Just one of the activities that we contribute to is the State Elks Major project, Copper Cannon Youth Summer Camp. This is a week free camp program for under privileged youths. To qualify for this the child only has to complete an application and medical form from doctor and qualify for the free lunch program in school. This does not mean they get free lunches because that is between them and the schools. What this means is their household income meets the same guide lines. We have been gaining in the number of youths sent to camp from our lodge area. Last year we sent 43 and this year we sent 47, with 2 more that were expected but had to cancel for personal reasons. Camp capacity at this time is 50 youths per week. With the completion of a new dining hall early next spring, the camp director hopes to be able to accommodate another 20 campers.

So any time someone asks you to help or donate to ENF just think of our youth of the community. Thank ENF for the money needed to do these worthwhile things. To list just a few of the programs sponsored by ENF, (Copper Cannon, College Scholarships which we give more than the US government, Our Veterans Programs, the grant money we receive such as that we are now using for the bicycle program we just had, along with many other community activities.
